

13th Maidenhead Scout Group 90th Anniversary Badge Competition!

To mark 90 years since the 13th Maidenhead Scout group was created we are running a competition to design a badge that all of our Beavers, Cubs and Scouts can wear on their uniform.

The competition is open to all current members of the group in any section.

The rules are as follows:


- The design should include our group name and be clear that we are celebrating its 90th anniversary.
- The design should use no more than seven different colours.
- The design can make use of the Scouting “fleur-de-lis” (as below) but no other part of the official Scout logos, and should not be designed to look like an existing activity badge or similar.




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- The design should fit one of the templates below.
- You may submit an entry on paper or as an electronic file (JPEG or similar).
- Your entry must be submitted by midnight Friday 27th September at the latest (due to tight turnaround times no entries after that time will be considered).
- The winning entry will be judged by the group exec, the decision will be final. Badges will be produced for distribution to all members at the annual bonfire evening on the 18th October.
- You should write your full name and section on the back of the entry form and hand it to your section leader. Electronic entries should be emailed to the Group Scout Leader (Charles Berger) at charles@thebergers.org.uk and will be printed, but please include name and section details in the email.
